How will I make a difference?

The Eric Liddell Centre provides a number of services which are important to the local community including a day care service and support work with carers, but not enough people know about us. We need your help to help us change this.



What will I be doing?

There is a wide choice of things you can do to help us reach the local community. You could be:

- distributing leaflets to libraries, doctors surgeries and keeping their supplies topped up.
- giving talks about our work to local organisations.
- helping us to recruit volunteer helpers by placing posters in suitable places.
- helping us spread the word through social media and other forms of communication.
- distributing and emptying collecting boxes.
- organising community fundraising events.
